City of Dellwood Council Meeting Minutes October 14th, 2025

The regular meeting of the Council of the City of Dellwood was held on October 14th, 2025, at the city offices located at 111 Wildwood Road, Willernie, MN. The meeting was held in person, and non-Council members were able to attend remotely via Zoom.

Mayor Mike McGill called the meeting to order at 5:31 PM.

Public Comment:

Mayor McGill noted that no one was present to make a public comment. John Carr remarked that a veteran cyclist, Tom Gunderson of Stillwater, died last week as a result of an accident while biking.

Agenda:

On motion by Quaday, seconded by Boosalis, the agenda for this meeting was approved as submitted.

Minutes:

The minutes of the September 9th, 2025, City Council meeting were discussed. Mayor McGill noted a typo under Item No. 1: the date of the community meeting in Mahtomedi was September 9th, 2025, not September 29th.

On motion by Ramsay, seconded by Boosalis, the minutes of the September City Council meeting were unanimously approved, with the foregoing corrections.

Item No. 1 – County Attorney's Presentation.

Kevin Magnuson reviewed the various duties carried out by his office. He has 61 employees, of whom about half are attorneys and half are office staff. The office receives about 1,500 referrals per year, and about 700 of those result in criminal charges. Approximately 85% of these cases involve drug and domestic assault, sexual abuse, and the like. He noted that various factors enter into the decisions affecting formal complaints, including victim cooperation issues.

He noted that license plate readers are helpful in resolving car thefts.

He discussed the prevalence of drug overdose cases and that his office is more focused on drug suppliers than users.

Joyriding by juveniles in stolen cars and drivers fleeing police appear to be on the rise in recent years. Cell phone history, when available, is valuable in finding runaway persons.

His office prefers to use diversion programs when dealing with juvenile offenders. The recidivism rate in such cases is about 10%. His office may certify a juvenile offender for adult prosecution in about 10% of the cases.

The Council expressed its appreciation to Mr. Magnuson for his appearance and comments.

Item No. 2 - Voter Fund Allocations.

Holstad distributed a summary setting forth the 2025 Voter Fund allocation among municipalities in Washington County, which showed that Dellwood had 885 registered voters as of May 1, 2025, and was allocated \$168.19 as its share of the fund.

Item No. 3 – 245 Dwinnell Avenue.

Mr. Copeland and Bridget Nason, Mahtomedi City Attorney, had agreed upon a Joint Resolution for the purpose of placing the property at 245 Dwinnell Avenue entirely into the City of Dellwood. This resolution was approved by the Council of Mahtomedi and has been signed by its Mayor, and the owners of the property have also signed it.

Upon signing by Mayor McGill and Clerk Holstad, this resolution will be submitted to the State Office of Administrative Hearings for approval.

On motion by McGill, seconded by Ramsay, the Council voted unanimously to adopt the Resolution and to submit it to the state office.

Item No. 4 - Amended Shoreland and Zoning Ordinances.

Nate Sparks had submitted his memorandum and proposed amended Shoreland Ordinance and amended Zoning Ordinance. The purpose is to separate those ordinances from the current comprehensive ordinance, as requested by the Minnesota DNR.

These amendments were heard and approved by the City Planning Commission on September 16, 2025.

Sparks noted that the DNR has reviewed the shoreland ordinances and recommended the addition of a water basin situated at Highway 244 and Peninsula Road.

McGill moved to approve the amended Shoreland Ordinance, and Boosalis seconded, with the addition of the water basin.

The Council voted unanimously to enact the amended Shoreland Ordinance, with the water basin at 244 and Peninsula Road being added.

Quaday moved to enact the amended Zoning Ordinance as submitted. Ramsay seconded. The Council voted unanimously to enact the amended Zoning Ordinance.

Sparks presented a proposed official summary of the two amended ordinances for publication purposes.

McGill moved to approve the summary as presented, and Boosalis seconded. The Council voted unanimously to approve the official summary for publication.

Item No. 5 – Apple Orchard Road Traffic Study.

Ramsay stated that complaints continue to be received about speed and other issues regarding Apple Orchard Road, including poor sight lines at Hwy 96.

He is recommending that a traffic study be conducted by City Engineer Cara Geheran, to include the segment from Hwy 96 to the railroad tracks.

The estimated cost is \$15,000. The study will address safety concerns for pedestrians and motorists using the roadway, and will include available data from the speed reader records.

Ramsay moved to approve the study at a cost not to exceed \$15,000.

Quaday seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved by the Council.

Item No. 6 - Hwy 244 Turnback and Update on Trail Issues.

McGill reported on his meeting with WBYC General Manager Chris Nathlich. They discussed the "pinch point" of Hwy 244 at the club's location. He stated that Mr. Nathlich is willing to work with the City to allow for a trail along 244. The Club may be looking for compensation in exchange for a potential land exchange and the construction of a tunnel under 244.

Ramsay reported that issues remain regarding the turnback of 244, including several culverts. Cara Geheran and he are continuing to meet, and Cara's report should be forthcoming soon.

Boosalis noted that the segment of 244, which is adjacent to the Peninsula wetland area, likely has a poor sub-base, and its reconstruction in that area needs to be included in Cara's report. The same may be true in the area adjacent to the lowland near Meadow Lane.

Boosalis reviewed his discussions with State Representative Patti Anderson. It appears to be clear that once the City accepts any of the funds the State has appropriated for trail purposes, the City will be obligated to complete the entire trail with the \$4.6 million appropriated, and will also be committed to using City funds to cover any shortfalls in funds. He is trying to set up a meeting with the Met Council, Minnesota Management and Budget Office, and Representative Anderson in order to clarify the City's responsibilities.

Item No. 7 – Highway 96 Naming.

Clerk Holstad asked that this matter be tabled until the November meeting so that Councilmember Melissa Peltier can be present.

Claims & Receipts List:

Ramsay moved to approve, and Boosalis seconded. The Council voted unanimously to approve the Claims & Receipts List for the month of September 2025, as submitted.

Reports of Commissioners:

Ramsay reported that some roadside brush trimming has been done on Apple Orchard Road. He noted difficulty in improving the sight lines for cars entering Hwy 96 from Apple Orchard Road.

Quaday stated a planned training fire is to be conducted by the W.B. Fire Department on Nov. 1, starting at 8:30 a.m. Council members have been invited to attend. Exact location to be decided.


McGill reported 10 new permits (8 remodel, roof, fence).

Due to the high volume of exempt applications, payment of additional fees prior to 30 days before your event will not expedite service, nor are telephone requests for expedited service accepted.

Data privacy notice: The information requested on this form (and any attachments) will be used by the Gambling Control Board (Board) to determine your organization's qualifications to be involved in lawful gambling activities in Minnesota. Your organization has the right to refuse to supply the information; however, if your organization refuses to supply this information, the Board may not be able to determine your organization's qualifications and, as a consequence, may refuse to issue a permit. If your organization supplies the information requested, the Board will be able to process the

application. Your organization's name and address will be public information when received by the Board. All other information provided will be private data about your organization until the Board issues the permit. When the Board issues the permit, all information provided will become public. If the Board does not issue a permit, all information provided remains private, with the exception of your organization's name and address which will remain public. Private data about your organization are available to Board members, Board staff whose work requires access to the information; Minnesota's Depart-

How You May Spend Gambling Funds

Allowable expenses - Gambling funds may be spent for allowable expenses, such as:

- gambling equipment (pull-tabs, bingo paper, bingo blower, paddlewheel tickets, tipboard games);
- · advertising;
- · printing raffle tickets; or
- any services or goods that are directly related to the conduct of your gambling.

Charitable contributions - Gambling funds may be spent for the following charitable contributions (lawful purpose):

- to or by 501(c)(3) organization and 501(c)(4) festival organizations;
- relieving the effects of poverty, homelessness, or disability;
- problem gambling programs approved by the Minnesota Department of Human Services;
- public or private nonprofit school;
- scholarships (if a contribution is made to a scholarship fund, it must be made to a nonprofit organization whose primary mission is to award scholarships);
- church;
- recognition of military service (open to public) or active military personnel in need;
- activities and facilities benefiting youth under age 21;
- citizen monitoring of surface water quality, with data submitted to Minnesota PCA;
- unit of government (NOTE: A direct contribution to a law enforcement or prosecutorial agency is not allowed);
- wildlife management projects or activities that benefit the public-at-large, with DNR approval;
- grooming and maintaining snowmobile or all-terrain trails that are grant-in-aid trails, or other trails open to public use, with DNR approval;
- supplies and materials for DNR training and educational programs;
- nutritional programs, food shelves, and congregate dining programs primarily for persons who are 62 or older or disabled;
- community arts organizations or programs;
- humanitarian service recognizing volunteerism or philanthropy; and
- acquisition and repair of real property and capital assets (contact the Gambling Control Board for requirements).

How You May Not Spend Gambling Funds

- Controlled contribution An organization may not retain any control over any contribution made from gambling funds. The only exception is for expenditures by a 501(c)(3) organization or a 501(c)(4) festival organization to its general fund.
- Financial gain A contribution or expenditure may not be made if it results in any monetary, economic, financial, or material benefit to the organization making the contribution or expenditure.
- Government An expenditure may not be made for:
 - influencing the nomination or election of a candidate for public office;
 - promoting or defeating a ballot question; or
 - any activity intended to influence an election or a governmental decisionmaking process.
- 4. **Law enforcement -** A direct contribution may not be made to a law enforcement or prosecutorial agency.
- 5. **Pension** A contribution may not be made to a government pension or retirement fund, such as a fire relief association.
- Conflict of interest A contribution or expenditure may not be made if it is not allowed under the conflict of interest provisions of the Minnesota Nonprofit Corpo-ration Act, Minnesota Statutes, Section 317A.255.
- 7. **Alcohol -** An expenditure may not be made for the purchase of any intoxicating liquor, wine, or malt beverages.
- 8. **Fundraising** An expenditure may not be made for fundraising costs, except as allowed for a 501(c)(3) organization or 501(c)(4) festival organization from its general fund.
- 9. **Other organizations** With few exceptions, gambling funds may not be contributed to other organizations or clubs such as veterans, fraternal, Lions, etc. unless it is a 501(c)(3) organization.
- Other contributions A contribution may not be made to a 501(c)(3) organization or another entity with the intent or effect of not complying with lawful purpose restrictions or requirements.







I Reviewed the Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement used by MnDOT and Mahtomedi in March, 2025.


- 1. The process was controlled by MS 161.16
- 2 The roadway segment being turned back was acknowledged to be in need of pavement repair and improvements.

A rough map was attached and the agreement stated that MnDOT"will confer" with Mahtomedi to determine the "final right-of-way limits".

Apparently, no actual survey of the ROW was required from MnDOT.

- 3. MnDOT agreed to deliver a "Notice of Release" releasing the segment to Mahtomedi. Thereafter, MnDOT would deliver to Mahtomedi the "necessary documents" conveying its interest to Mahtomedi. Those documents of conveyance are not described in the Agreement.
- 4. Mahtomedi assumed all liability for claims associated with the ROW arising after the date the Notice of Release was received. The city was "encouraged" to conduct its own geotechnical investigations and not to rely on any prior studies performed by MnDOT.
- 5. The maximum sum of \$7,514,585 was authorized to be paid to Mahtomedi from the State's Municipal Turnback Account, which is controlled by MS 161.083. The Agreement provided for a lump-sum payment in lieu of payment to Mahtomedi for all expenses incurred in making repairs and improvements to the roadway. [Minn. Rules 8820.2300 Subp.6a] As a part of this, it was agreed that MnDOT could suspend payment in the event of a government shut-down. MnDOT agreed to use its "best efforts" to secure appropriation of the funds. Any expenses incurred by Mahtomedi prior to appropriation, or in excess of the authorized amount, were at the sole risk of the city.
- 6. By accepting payment, Mahtomedi released MnDOT and all other state agencies or officials from any and all claims related to the condition of the ROW, whether known or unknown at the time.
- 7. All records of Mahtomedi relevant to the ROW are subject to examination by the State Auditor for a period of six years after the transfer

The statutory authorities used in this transfer may be different from those which apply to Dellwood because of population differences, but I am not sure of that. Joel has noted that in recent turnback situations, the appropriated funds were not sufficient to cover all of the expenses of the local jurisdiction].



CRIME-FIGHTING TOOLS YOU CAN USE

Reducing crime and improving quality of life is a team effort, and a well-informed citizenry plays an important role. Washington County offers residents tools to help them be proactive in staying informed and in keeping their families and homes safe.



First, county residents can sign up for <u>CodeRED</u>, which sends emergency and community updates on evacuations, shelter-in-place orders, police activity, missing persons and more via phone, text, email or app. The Sheriff's Office encourages all residents to sign up for this important free service — just scan the QR code above or text WASHINGTONMN to 99411.

Another free tool is <u>CrimeMapping.com</u>, an online database available for any county resident. This user-friendly web-based program offers a visual representation of incidents within our jurisdiction and allows for easy access to incident data, including incident type, date, time, location and case numbers, for up to 180 days. It includes these types of incidents: arson, assault, burglary, disturbing the peace, drugs/alcohol violations, DWI, fraud, homicide, motor vehicle theft, robbery, theft/larceny, vandalism, vehicle break-in/theft and weapons offenses.

Finally — and perhaps most importantly — don't forget: If you see something, say something. Our dedicated team of telecommunicators, deputies, and other first responders are here for you 24/7. When in doubt, call 911 — and not just for emergencies. When you call, our telecommunicators receive valuable information through advanced technology that supports a faster, more informed response. The same professionals who answer emergency calls also manage non-emergency lines, so you're not bothering them by calling 911. They'll simply ask if your situation is an emergency. If it's not, they may place you on hold briefly, but they'll make sure you get the help or guidance you need as soon as possible.

The most important thing is to report what you see when it's happening. We would much rather respond to a call and find nothing than miss the chance to stop a crime or help someone in need.


